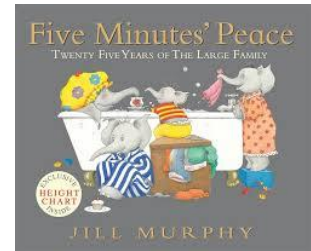

Our topic this term is Magical Me

<p>English</p> <p>We will continue to use the Read Write Inc scheme as part of our approach to teaching phonics, reading and writing. This term we will be enjoying stories with familiar settings. We will concentrate on the stories of Jill Murphy and Allan & Janet Ahlberg.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>We will continue to work on mental maths strategies - particularly counting on and back in ones and tens from a given number. Days of the week, months and seasons will also be an area we will concentrate on.</p>
<p>Science</p> <p>In Science we will be learning about ourselves. We will be identifying parts of the body and learning that humans have a skeleton. We will explore and use the 5 senses.</p>	<p>History / Geography</p> <p>In History we will be finding out about the life and work of Florence Nightingale and how medicine has changed over the course of time. In Geography, we will be studying our local area.</p>
<p>Art & DT</p> <p>This term in Art, Design and Technology we will be working on self-portraits, names and printing with parts of the body.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>In Music we will be using symbols to represent sounds. We will be singing songs about the body and harvest.</p>
<p>PE</p> <p>This term we will be concentrating on hand/eye co-ordination. We will be using these skills within games and challenges.</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>In RE we will be thinking about special times and how we celebrate them. We will also learn about harvest and how that is celebrated locally and around the world.</p>
<p>Personal, Health and Social Education</p> <p>In PHSE we will be thinking about caring for others, at home, at school and in the wider community.</p>	<p>ICT</p> <p>We will use the iPads to take digital photos of ourselves and our friends. We will also learn about the importance of using ICT responsibly.</p>
